

German Physicists' Tournament Rules

December 3, 2019

The physics fight's rule set is equivalent to the International Physicists' Tournament's rule set¹ concerning each fight (section 2) apart from a few adjustments. These are regarding challenging problems (section 2.7). Instead of the rules from this paragraph the following rules apply:

1. All problems presented during a PF must be different.
2. Each team has to submit a set of at least 3 problems considered to be solved, which will be challenged during the PFs.
3. No problem outside of these submitted problems is going to be challenged for the reports.
4. The problems submitted can be changed up until one week before the tournament.
5. The best three teams from the physics fights will compete in the final fight.
6. It is possible to oppose a problem that has been presented by the same team before.
7. There is one tactical rejection per PF without any penalty for the team.
